Dear Classic Owner,

We invite you to bring your prized car or motorcycle to Painshill Park, Cobham, on Sunday 24th July, when we will raise money for the following four Charities:-

Macmillan Nurses, The Princess Alice Hospice,
The Royal Marsden Hospital, Painshill Park Trust.

Admission to the park will be free for those arriving in a classic vehicle, which you will be directed to park in a reserved area over looking the lake.

Those of you who may not be aware of its background. Painshill Park was created between 1738 - 1773 by the Hon: Charles Hamilton, who included in its design a number of Follies, to amuse and entertain visitors. The park is situated next to the River Mole at Cobham and is acknowledged to be one of the finest 18th Century landscape gardens in the country. It was for many years in an overgrown state, its existence unknown, even to local residents. In the early 80's the site was acquired by the local authority with the view of restoring the garden. Painshill Park Trust, (which pays a peppercorn rent), was formed, to recreate in all it's former glory, this remarkable garden and lake, covering 158 acres. Due to the determination and efforts of the management team, staff and volunteers this intriguing place, is today much as it was in its heyday. The follies, including a Water Wheel, Turkish Tent, Hermitage, Ruined Abbey, Grotto, Gothic Temple, etc have been reinstated and the Vineyard replanted. In addition to Strolling around this fascinating setting, visiting the Follies as you go, you are welcome to bring a Picnic, which you will be able to enjoy whilst listening to live music. (near The Ice House), or in an area, where perhaps the sounds may be of birdsong, or perhaps that of water turning the Water Wheel.

As we are raising money for the above charities, by means of a "Sponsored Stroll" around the Park, we hope, that you or a passenger, may wish to join in the Stroll and make a donation of £10.00, however that is entirely your choice

Access for Classic Cars & M/cycles will be via a designated gateway (NOT THE PUBLIC ENTRANCE).
